Results:

The results of most laboratory tests are sent to your doctor within 3 to 5 business days. Some tests may not be performed at our hospital lab, and may have to be sent to a reference lab. These results may take longer to be sent back to your physician.

Copy of Results:

You may receive a copy of your results by:

- 1. Contacting your physician or
- 2. Accessing the FMH CARE patient portal by way of the Internet (not all results are available on the patient portal) or
- 3. Contacting FMH Medical Records Department at 240-566-3440 during normal business hours. You may be required to sign a release to obtain these results and any other medical records.

Bandage:

Tips to avoid Bruising

- 4. Leave the bandage on for a minimum of 30 minutes.
- 5. Avoid carrying heavy objects with the arm used for phlebotomy.
- 6. If bruising occurs, apply ice to the area.

Notify your

- 7. Pain continues or increases at the venipuncture site or
- Doctor if:
- 8. If a tingling sensation occurs below the site or.
- 9. If the area around the puncture site becomes excessively red after 24 hours.
