Helping all families regardless of income or background



NO COST TO RECIPIENTS

Families are not charged for the visits



THREE WEEKS

Visits are scheduled 3 weeks after baby's arrival




REGISTERED NURSE

All visits are made by highly trained nurses




Core Components of the Model

- Data and monitoring





Local Health Improvement Process (LHIP) Led to Family Connects

- Frederick Health and Frederick County Health Department collaborate on triennial Community Health Needs Assessment with Frederick County Health Care Coalition the nonprofit local health improvement coalition.
- For 2019-2021, adverse childhood experiences were selected as a priority by the Coalition. The Frederick County ACEs Workgroup identified Family Connects as a model appropriate to meet LHIP goals and complementary for the County's existing mix of services.
- ACEs Workgroup helped identify the clinical and administrative home at Frederick Health

Importance of "fourth trimester", custom postpartum plans and contact within the first 3 weeks postpartum

MD State Integrated Health Improvement Strategies



Reduce severe maternal morbidity rate.

Maryland Maternal Mortality Review Commission Report



Provide direct health care support prior to 42 days postpartum to prevent pregnancy-related complications

Frederick County Maternal Child Health Collaborative



Decrease disproportional pregnancy-related deaths of African American women

Frederick County ACEs Workgroup



Increase skills and services that help children and families develop resiliency to prevent adverse childhood experiences





Current Funding

- County Executive selected Family Connects for \$8M in American Rescue
 Plan Act Funds for 2022-2025
- Goal to establish long-term sustainable funding for the service

Achieving Universal Population Reach in Frederick County

2023

2000 babies born at Frederick Health to Frederick County Families

60% = 1200 Integrated Home Visits 2024

3300 babies born to Frederick County families

50% = 1650 Total Integrated Health Visits 2025

3300 babies born to Frederick County families

60% = 1980 Integrated Home Visits









