# CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR THE FMH GOOD SAMARITAN OF THE YEAR AWARD PROGRAM

The Good Samaritan of the Year Award is the highest recognition conveyed upon an individual by Frederick Memorial Hospital.

In 1990, the Special Gifts Committee of the Frederick Memorial Hospital Development Council proposed a method for recognizing extraordinary commitment and participation in community affairs. To accomplish this task, the Special Gifts Committee developed the Good Samaritan of the Year Award Program to identify and select deserving individuals in our community.

In the spirit of the Good Samaritan, this award will recognize deserving individuals for their participation and selfless commitment to improving the quality of life in Frederick County.

Each year, the Special Gifts Committee selects an individual(s) nominated from the community to receive this prestigious award. Announcement of the recipient(s) will be made at the annual Good Samaritan of the Year reception.

## CRITERIA

1. Actions or achievements that substantially advance *Frederick Memorial Hospital* toward fulfillment of its goals, or
2. Long term involvement in eleemosynary community service activities, or
3. Actions or achievements that substantially advance patient care, the economic health of Frederick Memorial Hospital, or the physical safety of its personnel or patients, or
4. Performance of a distinguished act in the interest of humanity and that epitomizes excellence and leadership.

## GUIDELINES FOR SELECTION

1. Nominations must be in writing. Nominations must be submitted by March 31, 2009, using the Good Samaritan Award Program Form.
2. All submitted nomination forms will be distributed to all members of the selection committee before the meeting for review.
3. Voting for the recipient of the Good Samaritan of the Year Award will be conducted by secret ballot at a selection committee meeting. If more than two nominations are submitted there shall be two ballots. On the first ballot, each selection committee member will be asked to vote for two of the nominees. Those two nominees with the highest number of votes will be placed on the second ballot. The nominees with the majority of votes on the second ballot will then be named as the Good Samaritan for that year. In the event of a tie, the chairman of the selection committee will cast the deciding vote. The committee may, at its discretion, select more than one Good Samaritan of the year.
4. The results of the balloting will be kept secret and the award will be presented to the winner(s) at the annual Good Samaritan recognition event.

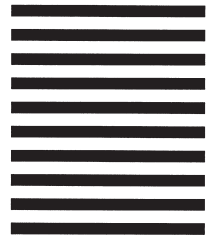
